CORVETTE RACING AT MID-OHIO: Garcia, Magnussen Back on the Podium!

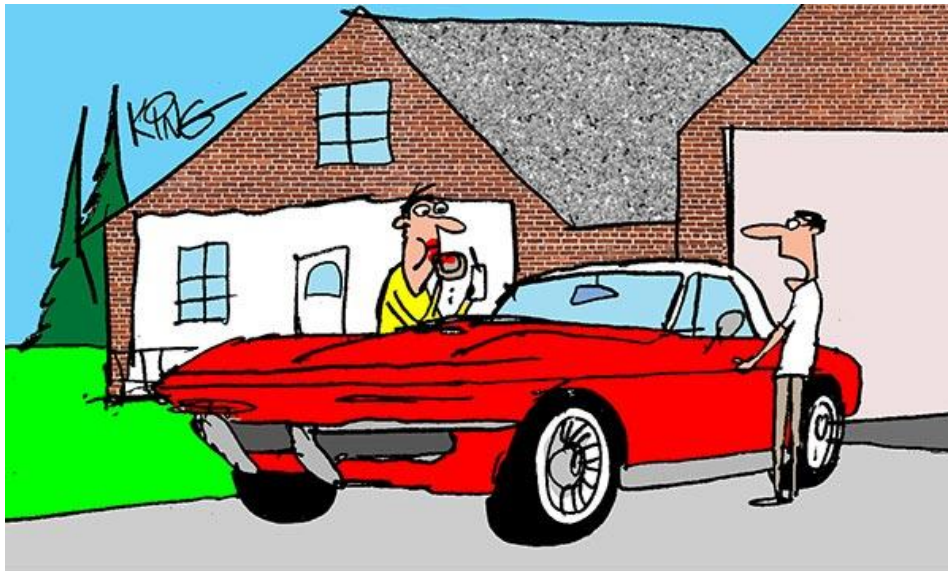
