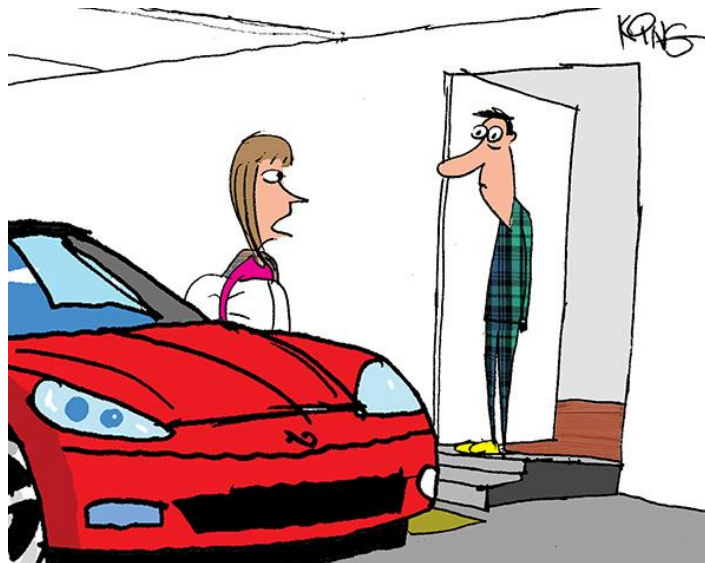
## Double Weekend at Sebring:
