

Report from Mecum Glendale Auction


I had the opportunity to attend the Mecum Glendale Auction on Friday, March 7, 2024. It is not nearly as crowded as the Barrett Jackson Auction which takes place in late January in Scottsdale. Barrett Jackson has an almost circus like atmosphere. Mecum is a basic straightforward vehicle auction.

There was no shortage of Corvettes of all generations for sale at Mecum. I had the opportunity to see approximately 23 Corvettes go across the auction block serially starting with a 1953 and ending with a 2024.
